Kids Cafe Delivers Meals Thanks to Donors Like You and the Landings L9 Golf Association

When the final school bell rings in May, summer begins-but for thousands of children across Coastal Georgia, so does uncertainty. Without access to school meals, many kids face long days without enough to eat. That's where you-and Kids Cafe-stepped in.

This summer, thanks to your generous support, Second Harvest of Coastal Georgia provided more than 183,000 breakfasts and lunches to children through the Kids Cafe Summer Feeding Program. Meals were served at 80 sites across 9 counties. reaching deep into neighborhoods where the need is greatest. Each meal was a moment of relief, comfort, and nourishment for a child who may otherwise have gone without.

With support from the Landings L9 Golf Association, we were able to purchase a new vehicle to help deliver these meals to schools, churches, libraries, community centers, and parkssafe, welcoming places that offered more than






















Do You Know the Difference Between a FOOD BANK and a FOOD PANTRY?

We're excited to introduce #GiveHealthy, a new way to fight hunger with fresh food —no shopping, no collecting, no delivery required.

HOW IT WORKS

- The #GiveHealthy team sets up a unique drive page for each organizer, tailored to their goals
- Organizers share the link or QR code with their network
- Supporters shop the virtual storefront, selecting healthy shelf-stable items or fresh produce to "add to cart"
- All items are sourced from local wholesalers and delivered directly to Second Harvest — at no cost to you or your donors
- Once the drive is complete and the food is received, Second Harvest will provide a donation receipt to the organizer for tax, sustainability, or corporate social responsibility tracking.
- This ensures the food we receive is as fresh as possible with maximum shelf life and impact.
- Supporters donate through a custom drive link, and the food is delivered to Second Harvest — fresh, fast, and hassle-free
